

## CHANGE IS COMING TO PBC!!

*We have it in the White House. Now change is coming to PBC Roller Hockey too! Announcing the proposed new **Player Changing Area** at the Pinckneyville hockey rink – a Gwinnett County park improvement project designed and built by and for the roller hockey community.*

GOAL: For years, our young hockey players have lacked a proper place to get dressed and ready to play. They have either suited up in the parking lot or lugged their heavy equipment bags to the front of the stands. Not only is there a complete **lack of privacy**, it's a **dangerous situation** too. Players, who are often unsteady on their skates, are dodging cars as they make their way to the rink. And fans and players alike are tripping over bags and loose equipment in order to get into the stands. The new Player Changing Area will provide a **safe and secure environment** for players to get dressed – one that will offer **privacy** without disrupting the game in progress or the fans' ability to watch it.

DETAILS: The Player Changing Area will be built directly behind the rink, and is designed to compliment the improvements Gwinnett County is making to the Pinckneyville hockey rink. Those plans include a new, pitched roof spanning the length of the rink and covering the stands, new dasher boards, plexiglass, a sport tile surface, new scoreboard and other upgrades.

This project will feature separate **Home and Visitor** changing areas that are separated by a narrow passageway. It will be surrounded by a **10' high chain link fence** with a privacy screen that will serve 3 purposes:

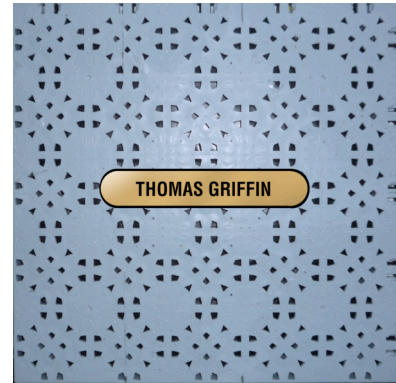
- It will allow players to get dressed and undressed away from public view.
- It will prevent equipment from getting lost and rolling down the hill behind the rink.
- It will provide security by allowing us to lock up our equipment inside when the rink is not in use.

A **diagram of the new area is attached**. It features **four 15' benches** in both the Home and Visitors dressing areas, which will provide plenty of room for players to get dressed and gear to be stored underneath. **Cabinets** in the middle will offer much-needed storage space for goalie equipment and other supplies. This will make it possible for goalies to suit up for their upcoming game without disrupting the one in progress (as is currently happening now). **New Entrances** from the Player Changing Area to the Home and Visitors Dugouts will enable players to enter the rink from the back side.

FINANCING: It is estimated that the cost of building the Player Changing Area will be about \$15,000. The funds need to be raised entirely through the efforts of the Peachtree

Booster Club and the roller hockey community. In order to do so, we have created 3 exciting new ways for people to become involved:

*BUY A TILE: We'd like to make our new surface a tapestry of all the kids, past and present, who've played hockey at Pinckneyville Park. For \$25, you can have the name of your young hockey player imprinted in 1" letters on one of our 10" x 10" sport court tiles.*

*BUY A BENCH: In the 30+ years of PBC hockey, many people remember their youth hockey days fondly and have gone on to successful careers. Here is a way*



*they can give back to their community and the sport. We have 8 benches we'd like to "sell" to families who are willing to contribute the \$750 cost for the bench and installation. In return, the bench will prominently display a plaque inscribed for the family that donated it.*

*SCREEN SIGN: For a \$600 fee, plus printing costs, advertisers can have their custom logo imprinted on the privacy screen of the Player Changing Area. Size will be approximately 4' x 4', depending upon the shape of the logo. This will be a permanent addition to the facility and cannot be changed or altered.*
